ASSEMBLYWOMAN HYNDMAN: DELIVERING FOR SOUTHEAST QUEENS FAMILIES

» Nearly \$3 billion for child care to expand eligibility for subsidized care and better support working parents



» \$1.1 billion for the Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP) and Landlord Rental Assistance Program (LRAP)

» \$475 million for additional Earned Income Tax Credit and Child Tax Credit payments



- » \$250 million to help New Yorkers pay back utility bills
- » \$585 million to suspend the state gas tax through the end of the year

» \$35 million for the Homeowner Protection Program (HOPP) to help New Yorkers at risk of foreclosure stay in their homes

» \$22 million for the Hunger Prevention Nutrition Assistance Program



» \$4.2 million for the Nutrition Outreach & Education Program (NOEP) to help those facing food insecurity

» \$3,000 bonus payments to qualified full-time frontline health care workers and an increase to the home care worker minimum wage by \$3 over two years
